Part - II

1) Introduction

Local Fund Audit has audited the accompanying financial statements of the Tamil Nadu Irrigated Agriculture Modernization Project financed by World Bank (under Loan No. 8797-IN), Government of Tamil Nadu and Government of India for the year ended on Mar 31, 2020. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

2) Scope of Audit:

The audit of the financial statements of Tamil Nadu Irrigated Agriculture Modernization Project financed by World Bank, Government of Tamil Nadu and Government of India for the year ended March 31, 2019 was conducted in accordance with the regulation and standards of audit of Comptroller and Auditor General of India. Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free of material misstatements. The audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts, internal checks and controls and disclosures in the financial statement. The audit also includes assessing accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall financial statements presentation. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.

3) DETAILS OF RECEIPTS AND CHARGES

III. The Role of TNAU

The project involves eight line Departments of Tamil Nadu Government and the TNAU is pivotal in execution of the tasks planned under component B.

3. SUBSIDY - DRIP IRRIGATION INSTALLATION AND FARM INPUT ISSUED TO FARMERS - INADEQUECIES

On verification of the documents related to installation of Drip Irrigation System in the fields of farmers and the farm input distribution registers of the farmers under the TN-IAMP Project the following inadequacies are observed.

a. Lease Agreement not produced

The document of land holding rights of the farmer is not indicated in the chitta and in cases where the said farmers are undertaking the lands under lease, no lease agreement executed. Hence whether the subsidy is given to the genuine farmer could not ascertained.

b. Adangal not produced

In case where agricultural inputs were issued to farmers beneficiaries and farmers who purchased inputs and claimed input cost, 'adangal' documents indicating the crop being currently and previously cultivated are not provided.

c. Check Measurement not produced

In some of the cases documents of check measurement were not enclosed in the drip voucher. Hence whether the installation of drip irrigation system in the fields of farmers genuinty could not ascertained. Hence the above documents produced to audit.

Project Implementation progress

INTRODUCTION

Project Out line

TANUVAS GRAND supplement developed by TANUVAS ameliorates nutritional deficiencies, in low yielders, and increases microbial proliferation resulting in improved milk production. The acronym for this supplement is GRAND in which G stands for Gruel, R stands for rooted, A stands for Additive, N stands for Nourishment and D stands for Drops. Experiments on the effect of GRAND supplementation have shown that the *in vitro* apparent digestibility of fodder and microbial biomass increases by three fold over non-supplementation group. TANUVAS GRAND supplement is beneficial to nitrogen deficient diet and is more effective when diet contains sufficient energy. TANUVAS GRAND supplement is expected to increases milk production by 500 ml to 700 ml /day/cow and potentially could lead to 20% reduction in methane emission per animal. To demonstrate this impact in the small holder dairy production system, TNIAMP project envisages to pilot and validate the benefits of feeding TANUVAS GRAND to 8800 lactating cows in the Phase-I project villages. The piloting will be undertaken in tandem with the activities of Animal Husbandry activities and will be implemented through the Dairy Interest Groups (DIGs).

Project development objective:

- Demonstrating the impacts of critical nutrient supplementation to dairy cattle to increase milk production and mitigate methane production
- Establishment of mineralized salt lick production units using TANUVAS technology for Dairy Interest Groups
- 3. Popularizing the technology for adoption.

Budget:

Rs. 2 crore has been allotted for six years; Rs.89,77,800/- was released in last two years for implementation of the activities.

Project activities in 2019-20.

TANUVAS TN-IAM project activities to popularize the nutrient supplemental strategy developed by TANUVAS among the farmers of TN-IAM project area of sub basins to increase the milk yield and to reduce methane production. In the year 2019-20, it has been implemented in 18 sub basins. The activities are executed from Institute of animal

nutrition, Kattupakkam as nodel office which is situated in lower palar region. Hence, an existing building was identified for the purpose and renovations were made. Utilising the budget alloted for this purpose, TANUVAS GRAND production plant was installed, having a total capacity of producing 2000 litres (3150 numbers of 600 ml bottles) of TANUVAS GRAND per day. The plant have the components of weighing balance – 300 Kg capacity, pulveriser – Capacity of 25 Kg per hour, RO system – 2000 litres per day capacity, TANUVAS GRAND plant having the capacity of producing 2000 litres (3150 numbers of 600 ml bottles) of TANUVAS GRAND per day. TANUVAS GRAND plant has mixer, storage unit, feeder unit, filler unit, labelling unit and capping unit. The plant was made operational and TANUVAS GRAND production has commenced.

Raw materials for the production of TANUVAS GRAND was procured. Packaging material for packing the finished product was also procured.

The Post supplementation data was collected and interpreted on TANUVAS GRAND supplementation and outcome is TANUVAS GRAND increases milk yield from 500ml to 1000ml in responded animals and reduces the methane production.

The other component of this project is setting up of mineralized salt lick production unit in farmers door step. To implement this activity, initially Fifteen to twenty five farmers were selected from each dairy interest group of sub basin for orientation training. Outcomes:

90 farmers were selected for technical training on salt lick production for three days at Institute of Animal Nutrition, Kattupakkam.

Technical training to members of selected groups

Farmers were trained on salt lick preparation for three days at Institute of Animal Nutrition by hands on training. It was conducted 30 farmers per batch, totally 3 batches. On first day, they were enlightened the various steps on preparation. They were divided as group with six members from different districts to handle them as group. Second day, each group was allowed to prepare the salt lick by themselves. Third day, the quality check and storage study were trained and also asked them check the quality of salt licks which they have prepared. Finally, the discussion was made with farmers with all technical staff to clear their doubts on salt lick preparation. The food and accommodation were arranged at training place premises. Travelling allowances were met out from the project. Totally, 90 farmers were trained.

Outcomes:

Among 90 farmers were trained, 14 farmers were selected to establish the salt lick production unit at their places based on their capacity to produce salt licks.
