In existing there was an open off take in Manimuthar River fed Hanumanthakudi Chinna Kanmoi of Devakottai taluk. The Open off take was completely filled up with silt and with juliflora jungles obstructing in flow from river.

Groyne details:

Length of Groyne wall : 25.00 m

River MFD : 1219.73 Cumec

Canal Discharge : 0.62 Cumec

Ayacut benefited : 60.87 Ha



- Construction of groyne wall to a length of 25.00 mts
- Construction of retaining wall to a length of 350.00 mts leading to supply channel from the point of level permits
- Trimming river course in upstream to Groyne
- Works almost completed in August 2008.



After Execution

Impact of the Project:

- Yield for the Hanumanthakudi Chinna Kanmoi has been increased by providing groyne and the benefited ayacut area has been increased.
- 2. The Ayacut area is being stabilized
